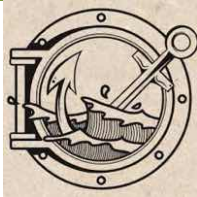

Sarva 4.5%

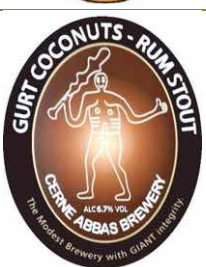
A pale, lower strength IPA with pine and citrus flavours from the American Cascade and Simcoe hops.

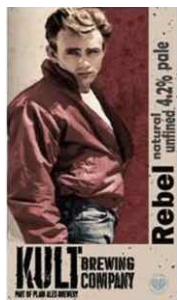
Flack Manor

Black Jack: Smooth, dark, ruby-coloured beer with rich aromas of toasted malt. An initial sweetness followed by a good, lingering hop finish and hazelnut after-notes. No specific notes available.

Kult (Plain Ales)



Rebel 4.2% (unfined)

New England IPA. It's natural, unfined and its vegan. It's hazy and it's juicy and it has a sumptuous velvety feel from the malted oats. The aroma and flavour characteristics of the ale come from a well balanced use of Idaho 7 and Comet hops to give tropical fruit and citrus (think apricot, orange, red grapefruit, papaya) with big notes of resinous pine and hints of black tea.

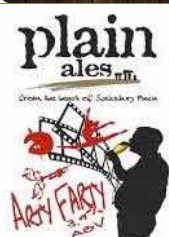
Pitchfork



Pitchfork 4.3%

Golden Ale. A golden bitter with a floral, citric hop aroma. It has a predominantly hoppy flavour which is slightly sweet and fruity.

Plain Ales

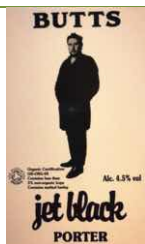


Arty Farty 3.9%

A refreshing, bright golden ale with complex tropical fruit notes: grapefruit, melon and Sicilian lemon.

Jet Black 4.5%

A porter with added port. Obviously.

Colly Fobble



Mild Tha' Knows 4.4%

Traditional Derbyshire mild. Dark mahogany in colour with a toffee, chocolate and coffee aroma and deep, rich and satisfying flavour.

Cotleigh



Snowy Owl 5.0%

A strong golden coloured winter ale. A full bodied long lasting and moreish ale with hints of citrus fruits. Brewed using only Pale Flagon malt with Goldings, Fuggles and Northern Brewer hops.

Fine Tuned



Sunshine Reggae 4.2%

A true to style American Pale Ale. Very hoppy with bags of character. A favourite at the brewery.

Milestone		Lock Keeper 4.4%	Bitter/ Brown Ale. Chestnut in colour with a creamy head that laces down. Aroma of malts and yeast. Flavour is caramelized malt with fruits below. Reasonably full bodied but still easy-drinking.
Old Pie Factory		I Pie A 4.5%	Session IPA. Clear, light amber in colour with a dry woody hop aroma. Flavour is lightly malty with some pepper spice and bitter hops. Medium bodied.
Parkway		Who's Ruffled Feathers 4.5%	Premium bitter. No notes available.
Sambrook's		Jaffa 4.5%	Chocolate orange stout. No notes available – brewery too busy to answer emails.
Welton's		Old Harry 5.2%	Premium bitter. Deep red coloured beer with a malty but nutty flavour, brewed using Sussex & East Kent Goldings hops.
